Don't Forget the Following:

- All full-day unexcused absences must be cleared in order to be eligible to participate in the end of the year activities.
 - If you have more than one **excused absence** per month during the school year, you will need to clear them in order to participate in the end of the year activities. Each full-day absence must be cleared via attending one full session of Saturday School.
- If you have any assigned Saturday Schools, he or she must attend. Failure to attend Saturday School will render you ineligible for the end-of-the-year activities.
 - Remaining Saturday school dates: May 5, 12, 19, 26

- If you have an excessive number of tardies, this will make you ineligible to participate in the end-of-the-school-year activities. Students may clear tardies through after school detentions. One 30-minute after school detention will clear two tardies.
- If you have an excessive number of period absences, you will be ineligible to participate in the end-of-the-school-year activities.

- For community service, the goal for this year's senior class is to have all community service hours completed and submitted before Wednesday, May 30, 2018.
 - If you are not aware of how many hours you have completed, speak with your counselor. Phone calls will be made as a reminder to those seniors who have not fully completed the required 30 hours. Final grades for all completed courses from the school site, APEX and adult school must be completed and posted by Wednesday, May 30, 2018.

If you are involved in any incidents which cause a major disruption or are in violation of district and school rules and regulations, you will be placed on the non-privileged list AND WILL NOT BE ABLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE GRADUATION CEREMONY JUNE 6, 2018 AT SOUTHWESTERN COLLEGE.
